A beautiful May day was the backdrop for the 5th Annual Outdoors Without Limits event at Hazel Hill Lake Conservation Area near Warrensburg on May 14th. The event for people with disabilities who live within the WILS service area is a cooperative venture by the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Stealth Gobbler Chapter of the National Wild Turkey Federation, Johnson County Community Health Services, Warrensburg Parks and Recreations Department and West-Central Independent Living Solutions.

A crowd of about 70 guests, staff and volunteers turned out to enjoy archery, fishing and target shooting supervised by staff and volunteers from the Missouri Department of Conservation. WILS, Bi Lo Country Mart and Warrensburg Parks and Recreation provided lunch for everyone. Johnson County Community Health Services donated the use of a portable hand-washing station for the day.

In addition to providing volunteers to help throughout the event, the Stealth Gobblers Chapter of the National Wild Turkey Federation presented a check for \$250 to Kathy Kay, Executive Director of WILS.

WILS provides many programs for those with disabilities including a ramp construction program, transportation program, and assistive technology program, among others.
