New Inclusive Playground Coming to Clinton

Henry County's first inclusive playground is being planned to make its debut in Clinton, MO. The playground's committee—comprised of various city employees, WILS staff and other knowledgeable community individuals—have been working together since March 2017 to research, plan and apply for grants to make the playground a reality.

The committee was careful to take many disabilities into consideration when choosing equipment, to ensure that it would be truly inclusive and allow every individual play on the structures and interact with each other, regardless of their abilities. In September 2017, the group toured 5 inclusive playgrounds in the Kansas City area, to better understand layout, structure and surfacing options.

After much consideration—for safety, access and convenience—the committee voted to have the playground built at The Benson Center. This complex already includes the communities dog park, skate park and, inside The Benson Center, are basketball/volleyball courts, indoor walking track, weightlifting area, indoor pools and play area and an aerobics area. An inclusive playground with outdoor accessible restrooms will pair nicely with the amenities already offered.

Currently, the City of Clinton is applying for grants and collecting funds for the project. WILS was one of the first to contribute money to help make this playground a reality, as independence is important to the organization on every level.





Ramp Donation Check

WILS donated approximately \$1,300.00 to Saline County Habitat for Humanity to cover the cost of materials to build two wheelchair ramps and one widening of a door; this generous donation allowed three individuals to have safer access to their home and their Marshall community.
